Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in MassDevelopment's Manufacturing Innovation Grants program. The MassDevelopment program connects Massachusetts original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) with one of four Innovation Centers – including Boston Engineering – to provide discounted services and expertise to help small-to-mid-sized companies grow.

The program is open to Massachusetts companies in need of expertise and equipment to support product development, prototyping, scaling production, cost reduction, and other assistance.

MassDevelopment selected the Innovation Centers based on their specific assets, their ability as individual organizations, and the broad based ability as a group. Together, the Innovation Centers offer a means to solve diverse technical problems in an effort to turn vision into reality, reduce production costs, and define process improvements.

Eligible companies will contract directly with one of four Innovation Centers and are free to [contact more than one in an effort to maximize their efforts](#). The Innovation Center will evaluate each project independently. Additionally, each Innovation Center will have the final decision on which projects it undertakes, based on each Innovation Center's understanding of a project and its own internal capabilities.

Grant Background

If selected, MassDevelopment will pay up to the lesser of 75% or \$75,000 of the cost of a contract between a manufacturing company and chosen Innovation Center. Companies will pay the remaining percent. The exact percentage may vary.

Applicants will be evaluated on a number of factors, including potential value to the program's overall success. However, if your organization is not selected initially, we will keep your application on file and will review it based on funding appropriations.

Grant Eligibility Requirements

- Companies must be located in Massachusetts
- Companies must have 100 or fewer employees
- Companies must be new customers of the contracting Innovation Center
- Recipients are required to complete a survey at the end of the contract. A second survey will be required at a later date regarding the impact on the number of employees, net income, sales revenue, and number of customers. While all company-specific data will be held confidential, aggregate numbers on total impact of this fund will be used by MassDevelopment
